



Things to Do

[Natural Bridge Caverns](#) - Travel through a half-mile of the largest and most spectacular show cavern in Texas. You'll walk 180 feet below the ground on a guided tour. See awe-inspiring, ancient formations centuries in the making and still growing today. Take pictures along the way because this is one walk that you will never want to forget.

[The Witte Museum](#) - Massive exhibits of dinosaurs, People of the Pecos and Texas Wild, and other rotating exhibits fill the recently renovated space with history, storytelling and interactive fun located on the banks of the San Antonio River. A catalyst of the Broadway Cultural Corridor, the museum is a San Antonio arts and culture staple with a 300-year old history that contributes to the city's rich cultural legacy. [Natural Bridge Wildlife Ranch](#) – Ostrich feathers, zebra ears, and buffalo noses so close, you could touch them. That's Natural Bridge Wildlife Ranch - one of Texas' most recognized family entertainment attractions. Meander through 450 acres of rolling hills, creek beds, and magnificent live oak trees, and witness the behavior of over 500 animals from 40 exotic, native and endangered animal species worldwide.

[San Antonio Botanical Garden](#) - Enjoy the garden's 38 acres including classic attractions like the Lucile Hasell Conservatory, East Texas Lake, Bird Watch Structure and Texas Native Trail.

[San Antonio Ghost Tour](#) – by Sisters Grimm Ghost Tours – A guided walking tour of downtown San Antonio. Hearing scary stories of ghosts and ghouls is even creepier done at night. Let your guide take you to some of the most haunted sites in the city. A costumed guide who leads the way by lantern sets this tour apart from others like it.
